Handball at School Project

Dear President,

We are more than pleased to inform you that the IHF intends staging a training course as part of the Handball at School Project in your country. After the successful conduction of 23 Handball at School courses in 2011 and 2012, the IHF will also continue the project in 2013, offering national federations on all five continents to host a Handball at School course in their country.

According to the course concept our experts will present handball to teachers who have only little knowledge about handball at three different places in your country. During the courses our experts will distinguish between the age groups 5 – 11 years and 12 – 17 years in order to adapt the course content accordingly. The teaching material produced by the IHF for this very purpose is composed for these age groups. There will be a 3-day course in every venue including 8 teaching units of 45min. There should be 40-60 participants per course. Details are attached hereto. However, this basic course concept can be adapted to the special requirements in each country.

Moreover we would like to tell you that the IHF managed to engage very experienced and highly estimated representatives who will act as experts during the courses. All our experts are experts in school handball; some of them are former international handball players or former head coaches.

In order to prepare the courses we would ask you to please tell us two course periods between 1 March and 20 December 2013 you prefer. Please note that you have to add a rest day/travel day in between (i.e. 3-days course – rest day – 3-days course – rest day - 3-days course). Upon receipt of your proposal the IHF will check the experts' availability and will inform you about the final course period without delay.

Finally you are kindly requested to complete the missing information in the attached questionnaire.
